DESCRIPTION OF ACTIVITY:

Undercover Purchase

SYNOPSIS:

On 5/1/05, S/A Ziesemer made an undercover purchase of a Ruger, model P95 DC, 9mm pistol, serial number 314-09405, from the tables operated by Alex OSINSKI, David BACON and an unidentified white male at the gun show located at the Clark County Fairgrounds in Vancouver, Washington.

NARRATIVE:

- On 5/1/05, S/A Ziesemer made an undercover purchase of a Ruger, model P95 DC, 9mm pistol, serial number 314-09405, from the tables operated by Alex OSINSKI, David BACON and an unidentified white male at the gun show located at the Clark County Fairgrounds in Vancouver, Washington.
- S/A Ziesemer approached the table operated by OSINSKI, BACON and an unidentified white male. S/A Ziesemer spoke with BACON and the unidentified white male concerning the purchase of the Ruger pistol. S/A Ziesemer was told the price for the pistol was \$350. When S/A Ziesemer asked about purchasing both the Ruger pistol and a Para-Ordnance .40 caliber pistol, BACON and the unidentified white male asked OSINSKI about the price for the two pistols purchased together. OSINSKI stated that he had just got the Para-Ordnance pistol from a guy and would not sell it for less than \$500. OSINSKI gave S/A Ziesemer his business card and stated that the card was not really for OSINSKI's gun business, but for his unrelated business (See Attachment 1). OSINSKI wrote his phone number on the back of the business card. S/A Ziesemer purchased the Ruger, model P95 DC, 9mm pistol, serial number 314-09405

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for \$340. S/A Zieseemer handed \$350 to BACON and BACON gave S/A Zieseemer \$10 in change. S/A Zieseemer stated multiple times that he lived in Washington state. TFA Schweigert was also present during the transaction. An audio recording was made of the transaction.

3. S/A Zieseemer stated that that he might want to purchase the Para-Ordnance pistol later. BACON stated that OSINSKI lived on the Southern (Oregon) coast but that BACON lived in Oregon closer to Vancouver. BACON stated that he could meet S/A Zieseemer somewhere to sell him the Para-Ordnance pistol. BACON wrote his phone number on the back of OSINSKI's business card. BACON stated that they had not decided whether to do the Puyallup (Washington) or Canby (Oregon) gun show.

SA Ziesemer: That's sweet.

Schweigert: Probably just loud as hell and fun to shoot with.

Unknown: Yeah.

SA Ziesemer: Oh I bet it's loud as all-get-out.

Unknown: (Inaudible)

SA Ziesemer: Yeah.

Unknown: Regular (inaudible) 308

Schweigert: Cool

SA Ziesemer: Yeah. Wait is it a 308?

Unknown: Yeah.

SA Ziesemer: Uh, was that the standard one or is that...

Unknown: Um, 30.06 was, you know, the original, and then when they re-changed it to the 308.

SA Ziesemer: Oh, okay. That's cool. Yeah, I'm going to go take a look at that Ruger.

Schweigert: Alright, thanks.

Background noise.

SA Ziesemer: How's it going?

Unknown: (Inaudible)

SA Ziesemer: Ah, yeah.

Unknown: Looking for something?

SA Ziesemer: Yeah, I think so. Well I spent all of my dad's money, so now I gotta' spend my money. I got my dad that SVT uh, what is it called, SVT...

Unknown: Yeah, yeah, yeah...

SA Ziesemer: That one right there.

Unknown: Yeah, they make a...

SA Ziesemer: But, I want a handgun.

Unknown: Okay

SA Ziesemer: I kind of like this one.

Unknown: Yeah

SA Ziesemer: But, I like this one better. It's more expensive.

Unknown: (Inaudible)

SA Ziesemer: Yeah

Osinski: And, I'll give it to you for 180 bucks each.

SA Ziesemer: Well, my girlfriend would kill me if I bought both.

Unknown: (Inaudible)

SA Ziesemer: I know, I know, you're going to give me that speech.

Unknown: (Inaudible) Where's that forty-five?

SA Ziesemer: See this is sweet.

Unknown: Yeah it is, see, Para Ordnance now they, it comes with, it comes with a ten

SA Ziesmer: Yeah

Unknown: Ten round mag

SA Ziesemer: Yeah

Unknown: But, you know with the ban gone

SA Ziesemer: Yeah

Unknown: I think that's a twelve

SA Ziesemer: Oh, really?

Unknown: Yeah

SA Ziesemer: Really?

Unknown: Yeah, or no, it's even more

SA Ziesemer: Oh, cause it's a forty.

Unknown: No, it's a 15, it's a 15 shot.

SA Ziesmer: Oh, really?

Unknown: So...

SA Ziesemer: Oh that's sweet. Do you have any of those mags?

Unknown: No, we don't.

SA Ziesemer: Oh.

Unknown: But you got the two tone wrap around grips. It's a Para Ordnance.

SA Ziesemer: Yeah, yeah, those are sweet.

Unknown: Right, it's gonna fit any of the holsters that are set up for, you know...(inaudible)

SA Ziesemer: Right, right, yeah.

Unknown: (Inaudible) 1911 type set up, you can't go wrong with it. It's about the best thing that ever came out of Canada.

SA Ziesemer: Yeah, ha ha, I love Canadian jokes. That's sweet.

Unknown: Yeah, there you go.

SA Ziesemer: But I have a 9, I have a whole lot of 9 ammo.

Unknown: Okay, well when you get that, and uh, that laser on that.

SA Ziesemer: Yeah. That's kind of cool.

Unknown: (Inaudible) but it's just this little switch on the bottom.

SA Ziesemer: Yeah. I'm, I'm still worried about that uh, that bill that there talkin' about

Unknown: Which one?

S/A Ziesemer: So I wanna' buy em' now. They are trying to pass a bill in Washington State that uh bans all handguns except a 10 round magazine. Yeah, I mean, which is basically like all of them.

Unknown: (Inaudible)

SA Ziesemer: Yeah, maybe I'll have to move to Oregon you know. Well, Oregon's got something like that too don't they? No there are trying to pass it aren't they?

Unknown: (Inaudible)

SA Ziesemer: Oh really? Yeah, I was going to say that Washington might get by, but I don't know about Oregon.

Unknown: Yeah we're a bit more organized and also, Oregon you know we've got. We had the C-W-P first, right?

SA Ziesemer: Yeah

Unknown: And also we're a Class three state

SA Ziesemer: Yeah.

Unknown: So I mean

SA Ziesemer: Yeah that's yeah or, how are they gonna' ban all of the other stuff

Unknown: (Inaudible) have money and oh, shit ...inaudible..

SA Ziesemer: Yeah, yeah, I know, dude, I'd love to save up and buy a silencer. But then I'd have to move to Oregon. Can you keep em', like if I live in Washington, can you just keep them someplace in Oregon?

Meisha: Um...I tell you what, I'm going to be, I'll be at the next uh Expo show.

SA Zieseemer: Oh, that Portland one?

Meisha: Yeah.

SA Zieseemer: Yeah?

Meisha: Um, you swing on by and I will make some introductions with you to a couple of the class II guys.

SA Zieseemer: Oh yeah?

Meisha: 'Cause I got a couple friends of mine that are uh, manufacturers.

SA Zieseemer: Oh cool.

Meisha: Okay, um (inaudible).

SA Zieseemer: Yeah, yeah. I'd like to do it for a 1022. Like a Ruger 1022.

Meisha: I'm doing one with a Walther. It basically (inaudible) 22, the shorty of this.

SA Zieseemer: Oh yeah I've seen those.

Meisha: I'm doin' uh, a nice suppressor on that, just waitin' for the paperwork

SA Zieseemer: Yeah. Yeah, that'd be cool.

Meisha: It's just

SA Zieseemer: Yeah.

Meisha: That's just fun. Um

SA Zieseemer: Yeah, that'd be sweet, but then can, can I keep it like in Oregon?

Meisha: I don't know, that's why I need the that's why I need ta' introduce ya' 'cause I don't want to give you the wrong answer.

SA Zieseemer: Oh, okay.

Meisha: So I'll ask (inaudible)

SA Zieseemer: Yeah, yeah..

Unknown: Are you ready to buy that one?

SA Ziesemer: No, I don't know if I really want that one.

Schweigert: I think it's too much.

SA Ziesemer: Yeah, that's too much. I kind of want both of these 'cause I have a 9 so I've got a ton of 9 ammo, but the (???) it's a 40 which I like better. Yeah this is sweet, the Para Ordnance.

Schweigert: That'd be cool.

SA Ziesemer: So, how much for both together.

Unknown: Para Ordnance and the a

SA Ziesemer: Do I get a combo discount?

Schwciert: Group discount?

Bacon: (Inaudible) take like 25 dollars off the (inaudible).

Unknown: So these two, or that one.

Osinski: I'll go eight

SA Ziesemer: Yeah, I don't know if I can swing that. What, what are they separate?

Osinski: 350 and 5. And 5 is like a blowing out now price. That's a low price on that one.

SA Ziesemer: Yeah, I, I know. Yeah

Osinski: I'd go 8 for both, but otherwise I'll just keep em'.

S/A Ziesemer: Yeah

Osinski: I mean cause the Para, the Para's go for more money than that.

SA Ziesemer: Yeah, I know, and I mean that's a sweet one. How many does this mag hold?

Bacon: It comes with 10 rounders

Unknown: Two tens ...inaudible..

Three people talking at the same time

SA Ziesemer: Yeah, see, I want to get those now before anything happens.

Osinski: There's a few guys around that have em'

Bacon: And you can get 12's for the uh, the 40's

Unknown: Actually it's a 15.

Osinski: Yeah, yeah

Many people talking (???)

Bacon: Really, oh you can get fifteens for that too

SA Ziesemer: Yeah, that's sweet.

Many people talking (???)

Osinski: I just got this from a guy. And I'd just as soon if I can't get five I'd just soon take it home.

SA Ziesemer: Yeah, yeah, I under, I understand you guy's, you guy's are tryin' ta' do business too.

Osinski: (inaudible) get this with something else, you know, I can work with you.

SA Ziesemer: Yeah.

Osinski: I got a deal when I got that, where, you know, if I get three, I'm not losin', but

SA Ziesemer: Yeah. Well, it looks like everyone packing up, I came kind of late, but, um, sure why don't I get the, the Ruger and then I'll see if I can spend my, the rest of my wad.

Osinski: Well the Ruger is at 350 if you are not getting anything else.

SA Ziesemer: Yeah

Osinski: Yeah. But I'll, I'll give you the Ruger for 350.

SA Ziesemer: Okay.

Osinski: And that's with the laser, you know (??)

SA Ziesemer: Yeah

Osinski: It looks a little goofy, but it actually works really well.

SA Ziesemer: Well, how much is, this is a 32 I don't really wanna'...

Schweigert: Yeah, but we could get a can for that. Probably make a can ourselves

Bacon: (???) And that's a Nazi mark from World War II production pistol

Osinski: It's a little bit more of a collector thing than a...

SA Ziesemer: Yeah

Schweigert: You couldn't get like an after market barrel that's threaded for that?

Osinski: Naw, not on that

SA Ziesemer: It's too old, it's like old like

Osinski: If your gonna' do that kind of thing you want to get a Makarov

Schweigert: Yeah I've heard about those I wouldn't mind you don't have any of those do you?

Osinski: No

SA Ziesemer: Is this uh, like uh compensator or anything or that's just how you adjust

Osinski: Not that's just the way they attach the front sight.

SA Ziesemer: Oh, okay, okay. Alright, well...

Unknown: Less wind resistance, you can run faster.

SA Ziesemer: Don't run with knives or scissors, but guns, you're cool.

Unknown: It's cool man

SA Ziesemer: Alright, well, I think I'll get that one, and uh whatta' you think about like 325.

Osinski: No 340.

SA Ziesemer: Alright 340, sold. And then I'll shop around, but if I come back and I do get that Para Ordnance maybe we can, then you can help me out a little bit.

Osinski: Okay.

SA Ziesemer: Or maybe when I get paid later, do you guy's have a card or anything.

Bacon: Yeah, I'll get you one. Have Alex write his cell phone number on the back of that

SA Ziesemer: I get the, I get two mags too?

Bacon: Yep

Osinski: Yeah, you get two mags

Bacon: So you might want to put one of these in your pocket .

SA Ziesemer: Yeah, because it won't fit in there?

Osinski: Yeah, well the zip tie

Bacon: There both not going to fit because we have a zip tie on it and you can't have a gun in here that is not set up with a zip tie on it.

SA Ziesemer: Oh, okay, I see.

Bacon: So with the safety lock

SA Ziesemer: Will it fit even in there with a zip tie?

Bacon: I don't know let me take a look, let me take a look here

SA Ziesemer: Yeah, that thing's sweet, I can't wait to shoot it.

Unknown: You got some ammo for it?

SA Ziesemer: Uh, no, I'm going to let my dad buy that.

Schweigert: 7-6-2 by fifty four

SA Ziesemer: Yeah, I'm going to go look at that ammo wholesaler.

Background Noise

SA Zieseemer: Ah, thank you.

Osinski: That's not really my gun business, it's my unrelated business, if you just want to get a hold of me.

SA Zieseemer: Okay, and your name is Alex?

Osinski: Yeah.

SA Zieseemer: Okay, yeah, I mean ah, I got to wait until I save up maybe.

Schweigert: Can you get a hold of those Makarov's

Osinski: Um, personally no. Um where's that (???). Um, but there's a few guy's out here that gotta' em'.

SA Zieseemer: Yeah

Osinski: They're like 200 dollars.

SA Zieseemer: Yeah

Schweigert: (inaudible) thread the barrel?

Osinski: Oh you buy those separate they ain't gonna' sell em' with (inaudible)

Bacon: What I did here, if you want to put the extra mag in, I zip tied it so it's disabled,

SA Zieseemer: Okay, yeah I got it in my pocket.

Bacon: but it uh, but you can still put the mag in

SA Zieseemer: Okay, cool.

Bacon: So that way, that way you don't have to worry about losing anything....fit in the case

SA Zieseemer: And then can you get ah the 15 round mags for this one.

Osinski: Oh the guys over here just got em'.

SA Zieseemer: Yeah okay cool.

Bacon: And you can buy those on Ebay.

Osinski: Yeah

SA Ziesemer: Oh, really? You can, You can buy all that stuff on Ebay.

Osinski: No not the 15's are hard to get yeah, I'll show you. You got the money?

SA Ziesemer: Yeah, yeah, yeah, probably should do that huh?

Osinski: Yeah

SA Ziesemer: You probably want your money.

Osinski: I'll take you over where a guys probably got some mags

SA Ziesemer: Okay

Osinski: That was 340

SA Ziesemer: All my hard earned money

Bacon: Well there's nothing better to spend it on.

Schweigert: (Inaudible)

SA Ziesemer: Yeah, no you'll pay me back right when I get home. Do you have, uh, I'll give you a 50 do you gotta' 10 for change? How much, how much for these?

Bacon: Those are 20.

SA Ziesemer: How much?

Bacon: Twenty

SA Ziesemer: These are the good ones right?

Bacon: Yeah, they are Teflon coated.

SA Ziesemer: Cause, but uh, isn't it what, like the colored springs suppose to be better?

Bacon: Yep, no the thing that is important is the green follower

SA Ziesemer: Oh, okay

Bacon: That doesn't over-compress your mag springs. These are actually made at the same factory that makes the mags for Bushmaster.

SA Zieseemer: Oh yeah?

Bacon: Yeah.

SA Zieseemer: Okay

Bacon: They're Teflon coated, they've you know the high quality springs and follower. If you want to get a few of those, I could even work with you on the price.

SA Zieseemer: Yeah, maybe. Um, alright, are you guys going to be up, is there another show in Washington anytime soon.

Bacon: Um, um, there's one in Puyallup, but we might be going to the Canby show near Portland.

SA Zieseemer: Oh

Bacon: We haven't decided which one we are going to do.

SA Zieseemer: Okay. I'm mostly between here and uh, Seattle.

Bacon: Yeah, but you have, you have his card?

SA Zieseemer: Yeah. I got his card, yeah

Bacon: He can, he can get a hold of a me, I live just across the river, and I do a lot of local deliveries in the area.

SA Zieseemer: 541?

Bacon: Yeah he's down south coast.

SA Zieseemer: Oh, Okay. See I'm up here, so it's kind of a?

Bacon: Yeah if you want to pick somethin' up locally (???) well, let me write my number down for you too?

SA Zieseemer: Yeah, yeah, yeah. But could you get through him and then I'll just meet you up here or somewhere.

Bacon: Oh yeah. And it's like the mags, I have a big stack of those.

SA Zieseemer: Oh cool

Bacon: You know, so if you ever um.

SA Ziesemer: You don't have any mags for this one I bought my dad do you?

Bacon: Uh no

SA Ziesemer: No, okay. Alright, thanks David. See ya guy's. Uh What time is it? It's about 2:40. Want to do one quick loop ant then you ready to go?

Schweigert: Yeah.

SA Ziesemer: I'm going to look at that ammo. 275 a box, that's pretty good. You work here? Yeah. Don't want Wolf

Schweigert: No

SA Ziesemer: Why is that?

Schweigert: Bad

SA Ziesemer: Bad?

Schweigert: Bad ammo.

SA Ziesemer: Really, is it corrosive?

Schweigert: No, it's not corrosive, it's bad. Doesn't work

SA Ziesemer: Oh really?

Schweigert: Yeah, like one out of ten rounds

SA Ziesemer: Bad primer?

Schweigert: Bad everything

SA Ziesemer: This is sweet.

Schweigert: What's the price on that?

Unknown: Like the Ruger.

SA Ziesemer: Yeah, yeah, it's sweet.

Unknown: No it's not, it's a handgun.

SA Zieseemer: Oh, it's a ruger

Unknown: What?

SA Zieseemer: Oh, it's a 9mm. P uh, whatever uh, P-95

Unknown: How much ya' want for it?

SA Zieseemer: Uh, 400.

Unknown: Yep, I'm gonna' pass, thank you.

SA Zieseemer: Okay.

Background noise

SA Zieseemer: Makarov pistol parts. Are you ready to take off?

Background noise.

Schweigert: Yep (inaudible) put my sunglasses on

SA Zieseemer: Alright

Schweigert: (Inaudible)

SA Zieseemer: Everyone's packing up. This is when you get the good deals

Schweigert: No doubt. They do not want to carry out

SA Zieseemer: Yeah exactly. I'd like one of those 38, like light weights (????).

Schweigert: The air frames?

SA Zieseemer: Yeah I'd like one of those. Didn't enter the door prize: Oh the cash machine here is key. Oh, there you are sir. Yeah, I don't want uh stick me with that bayonet. I'm going to call my dad. Hey dad, hey ah, we are on our way out and I got that rifle for you. That guy is packing up and he's getting ready to leave pretty soon, yeah, and then ah, I got a 9mm pistol from the other guy. So I'll hit you up in a second when I get to my car. Okay. Do you want us to stay around to help you uh, follow maybe? Okay, that might work out. Well meet you over there, bye. Want to go shoot that?

Schweigert: No.

SA Zieseemer: That guy wanted to by this.

Schweigert: I heard that, just caught the last end I was goin' Ben gonna' sell it? Damn

SA Zieseemer: Said these mags were 85 bucks

Schweigert: (???) different modelsinaudible....

SA Zieseemer: Yeah, yeah, we'll see. Probably an expensive vault gun. Hopefully my car's still here.

DESCRIPTION OF ACTIVITY:

Undercover purchase of firearm from Alex OSINSKI

SYNOPSIS:

On May 2, 2005, ATF CI-111 purchased a firearm from Alex OSINSKI. The purpose of the firearm transaction was to show OSINSKI was continuing to sell firearms without a license and to set up future deals for additional firearms.

NARRATIVE:

1. On April 26, 2005, ATF CI-98 informed S/A Mike McNall that CI-98 had talked with Alex OSINSKI. CI-98 stated that OSINSKI told CI-98 that he would be attending a gun show in Vancouver, Washington on April 30, 2005 and May 1, 2005. CI-98 stated that OSINSKI further told CI-98 that he would be getting a hold of CI-111 to see if CI-111 wanted to purchase any firearms.
2. On April 29, 2005, CI-111 informed S/A McNall that OSINSKI had telephoned CI-111 and left a message to call him on his cell phone at (541) 556-5148. CI-111 stated that CI-111 attempted to contact OSINSKI, but was having trouble getting through to the number OSINSKI wanted CI-111 to call. CI-111 believed there might be something wrong with OSINSKI's voicemail.
